Youth Matters

Introduction

On the 18th July the Government published the Youth Matters Green Paper (somewhere to go something to do) with a closing date for consultation with young people set for November 2005.

The Voice and Influence team within the Youth Service undertook the task of going out into their areas, which combined cover, the whole borough of Barnsley and asked young people to fill in the questionnaire that had been compiled by the DFES.

2,139 young people participated in filling in the questionnaires. The workers accessed young people through Secondary Schools, on the streets and in Youth Centres. What follows are the responses for all the young people that participated, shown area by area.

Summary of findings from Youth Matters consultation

Question 1- What activities do you do in the evenings or weekends?

When asked the above question the majority of young people answered 'meet friends' closely followed by 'watch TV'. However, the young people who could not be identified by what area they came from had 'meet friends' as their first choice and 'play sport' as their second choice. Shopping and playing sport was also very popular amongst all the respondents.

Question 2. What activities do you wish were available in your area but currently aren't? (No graph)

Young people were just asked to make comments. A full list of all the comments can be found within the report.

Question 3. If you had the opportunity to do up to four hours of activities, including sport, in your spare time each week, would you make use of it?

When answering this question between 60% to 80% of all the young people answered yes. Although area six young people only had 60% yes answers they did have 40% of young people who answered not sure.

Question 4. Where would you like to go to be able to meet friends?

In answering this question the majority of young people answered go to the 'local park' followed closely by 'go shopping'. Area five young people had 'youth club' as their first choice followed by 'local park' just ahead of 'shopping'. What was interesting was that young people preferred youth centres rather than mobile youth centre however, this would have to be researched in more depth for it would be wrong to assume whether young people were clear about what a mobile youth centre can offer or what was their experience of attending youth centres.

Question 5. If there were more places for young people to go, do you think it would stop some teenagers getting into trouble?

The majority of young people answered yes to this question ranging from 55% to 80%. There was little difference between not sure and no answer. These only accounted for 5% to 20% of responses.

Question 6. How would you like to be involved in improving things for teenagers in your area?

The option that most young people chose was to 'help decide on how your local Council spends money on providing activities.' Approximately 55% to 68% chose this option. Also, between 20% to 33% of young people would like to 'take part in inspection of how good local activities and services are'.

Question 7. How would you like to tell your local Council what you think about activities and services for teenagers?

Between 45% to 55% of young people would like to fill in questionnaires and 15% to 35% would like to attend meetings, having your say on a website or by email or through your school or college in order to tell the local Council what you think about activities or services. In area two 35% of young people identified 'through school or college' as their second choice. What was encouraging was that only a small percentage chose the option of not wanting to be involved.

Question 8. Would a card that gave you discounts and money to spend on activities encourage you to do more activities in your spare time?

In answering this question a resounding 75% to 90% answered yes. There were more 'not sure' answers than the 'no' answer option. Only 1% to 10% answered 'no'.

Question 9. Do you think your parents would top up your card with money for you to spend on activities?

Between 50% to 68% of young people answered yes to this question. 20% to 35% of young people answered 'not sure' Only the young people who could not be identified by area chose 'no' before 'not sure'.

Question 10. We think that young people who misbehave or commit crimes should not get these discounts and top-ups. What do you think?

Approximately 54% to 70% of young people agreed with this, with area seven having the highest percentage agreeing (70%). 17% to 23% of young people spread across all areas were not sure followed by disagree. Area six young people just disagreed slightly more than not sure. However, 55% of young people from area six did agree.

Question 11 – Would you help out more in your community if what you did was recognised in some way?

Approximately 45% to 65% of young people answered yes to this question. Followed by approximately 20% to 40% answering not sure. Young people from area six had the lowest number of young people answering yes to this question at 45%, however the area had the highest number of young people at 40% who were not sure. No area other than area six had more than 10% answering no.

Question 12 – What kind of recognition or reward would encourage you to help out more in your community?

This was a multi choice question and therefore it is hard to measure percentages. Answers to this question were spread amongst things like CD's, ring tones, extra top up's on your card to spend on activities and the chance to win the opportunity to attend big events or meet important people.

An interesting finding when we asked this question was that although awards and certificates were recognised, as a reward by a number of young people the majority of young people would like something more significant. This may give local businesses the opportunity to become involved in different forms of sponsorship.

Question 13. Who do you go to now for information, help and advice? (for example: parents, friends, teachers, connexions, youth worker, social worker, help lines.)

Young people were just asked to make comments. A full list of all the comments can be found within the report.

Question 14. What do you think about the information, help and advice you receive?

Young people were just asked to make comments. A full list of all the comments can be found within the report.

Question 15 – How would you like information and advice on your future education and career choices to be provided?

A large number of young people answered by saying face to face, at approximately 43% to 65%. This was followed closely by popular choices such as, work experience, websites and visits from young adults already in work. After this followed telephone calls and text messages.

Question 16 – If you were experiencing problems in your life, would you like to have one professional person you can trust to go to for advice and information?

A large majority of young people from all the areas would like to have a professional to go to for information and advice. Between 25% and 35% said that it would not make any difference to them. Less than 11% said that it would make it worse, with young people from area three and nine answering the most in this category.

Question 17 – Do you currently help out in any of the following ways?

This was a multiple-choice question and answers were spread amongst all of the possible answers. A number of young people ranging from approximately 20% to 45% said that they help out with younger pupils at school or college. Similarly a number of young people ranging from approximately 22% to 40% said that they do things to help out in their area.

This feedback shows that young people from area two help out the most in all ways, compared to young people from area eight that help out the least in all ways.

Question 18. Would anything make you want to get involved helping out in your local area or with young people?

Question 19. Is there anything else we should consider to make it better for teenagers?

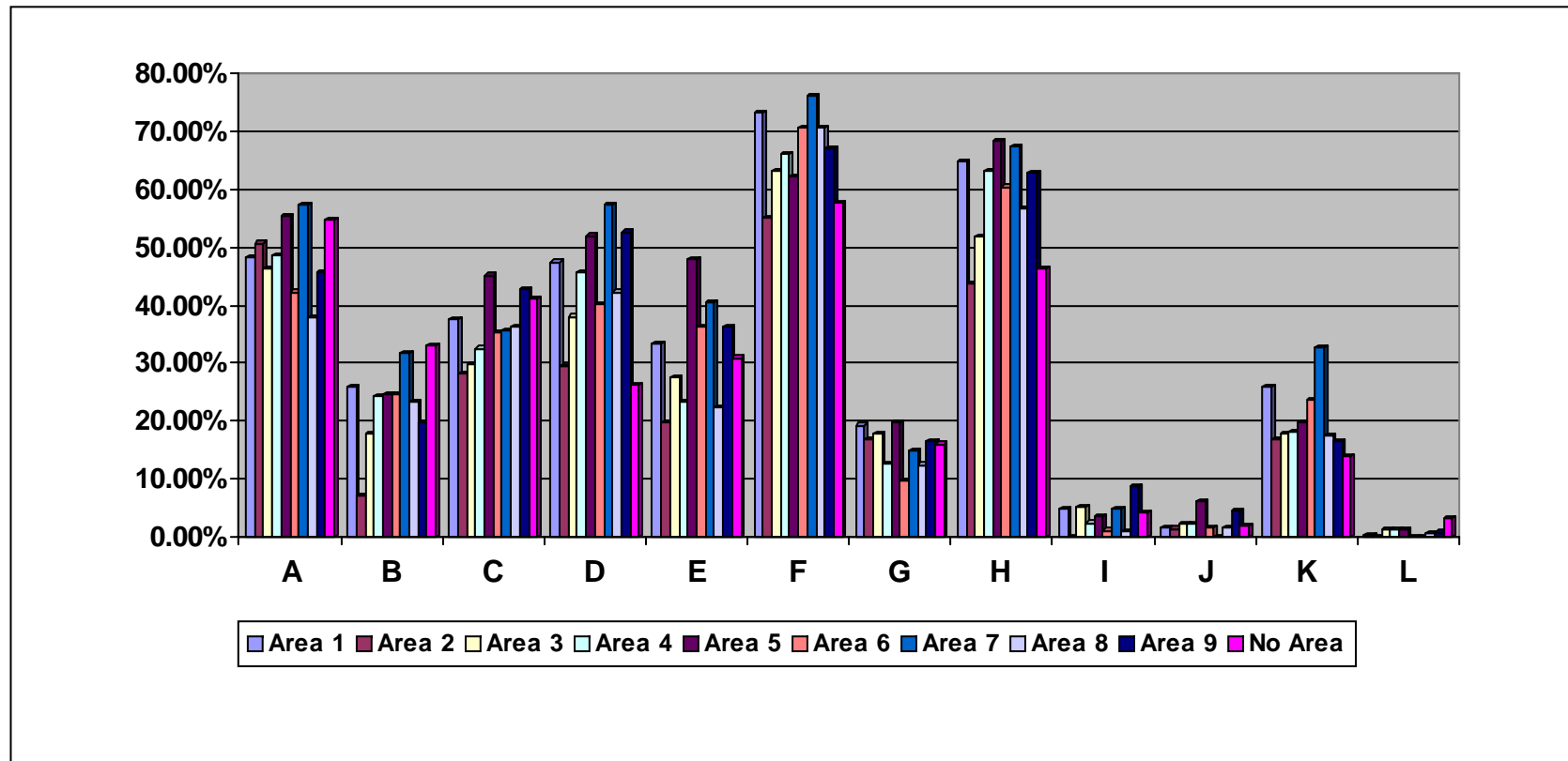

Profile of respondents

- 47% were male, 51% were female and 2% did not reply to this question.
- The majority of respondents were aged 13 to 16 years of age. 85% of young people within area six were aged 13 to 16 years of age and area eight had around seventy percent that were of this age band. Area two had over 75% aged 12 years of age. Area seven had just below 50% aged 12 years of age. Young people who could not be identified by area accounted for approximately 35% of young people aged 17 to 19 years of age.
- 12% of young people in area 2 acknowledged that they had a disability and or special needs. Area five had approximately 10 who also identified this.

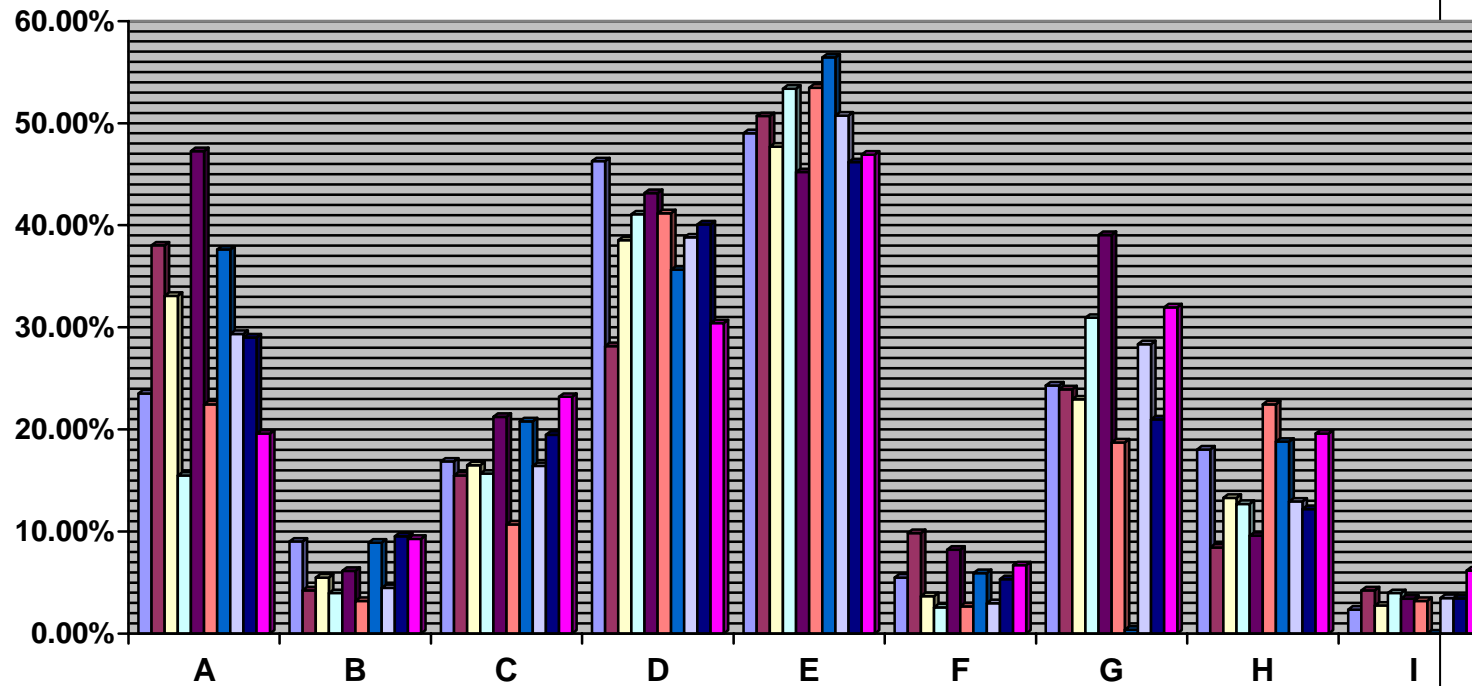

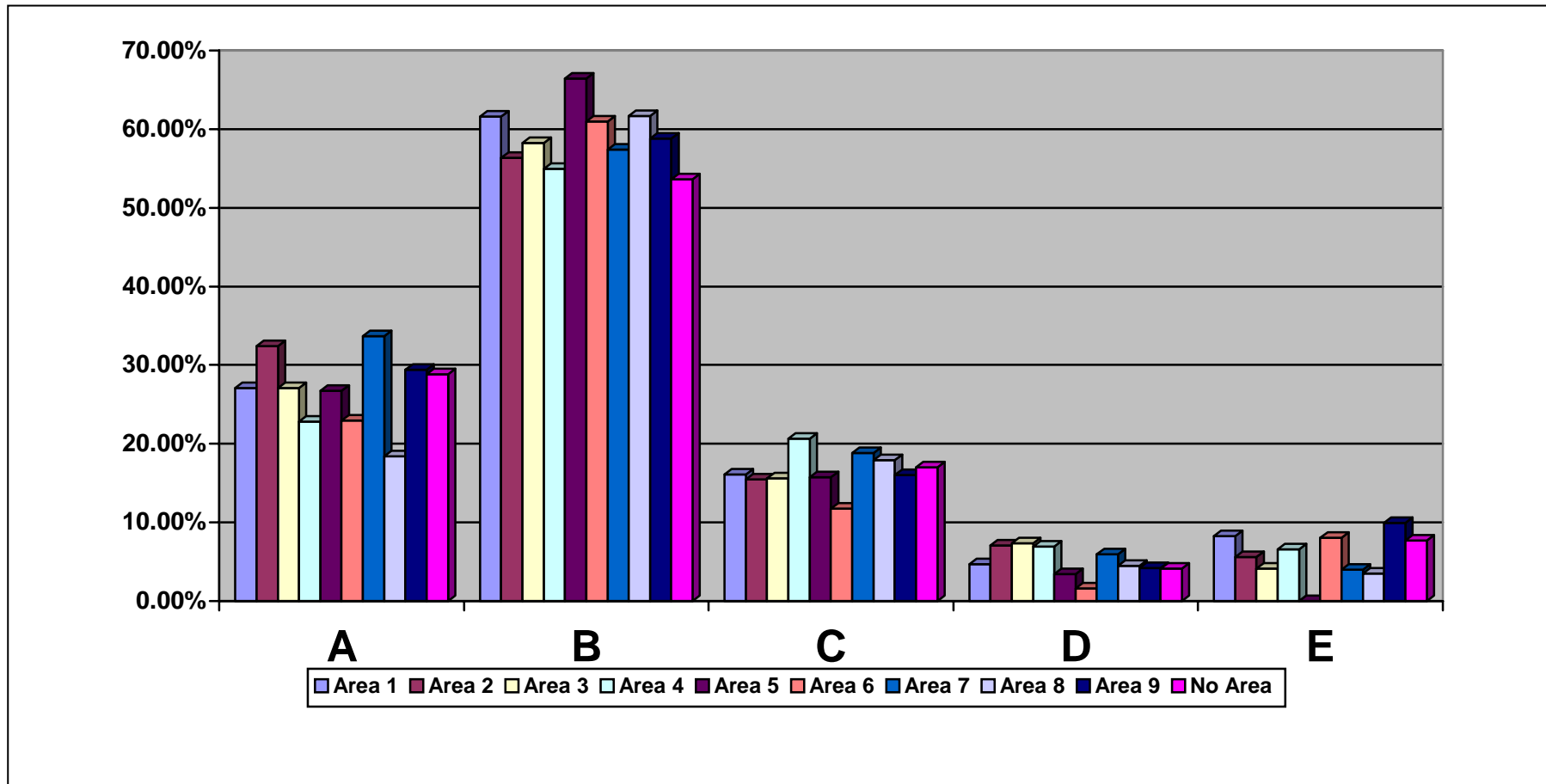

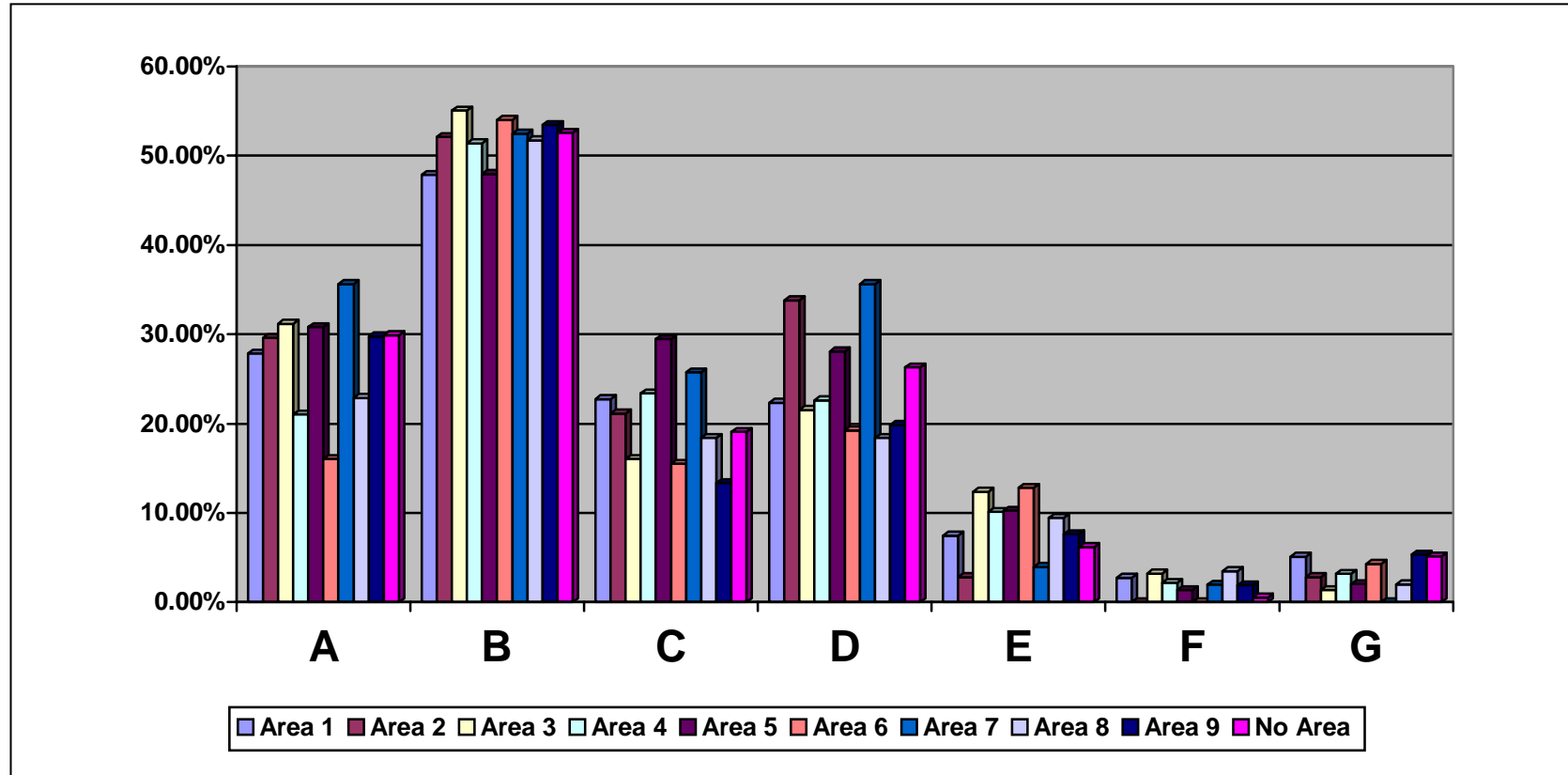

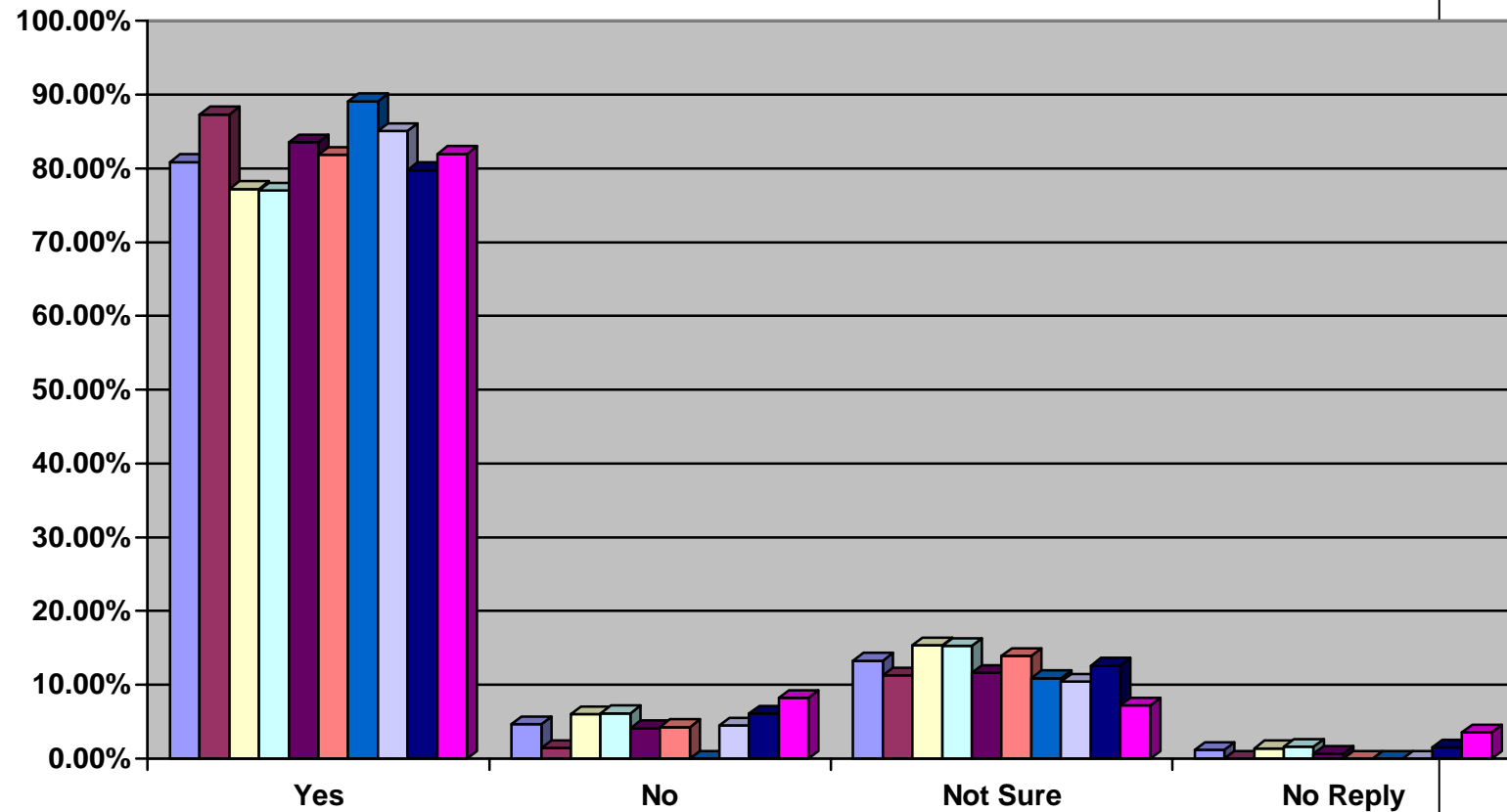

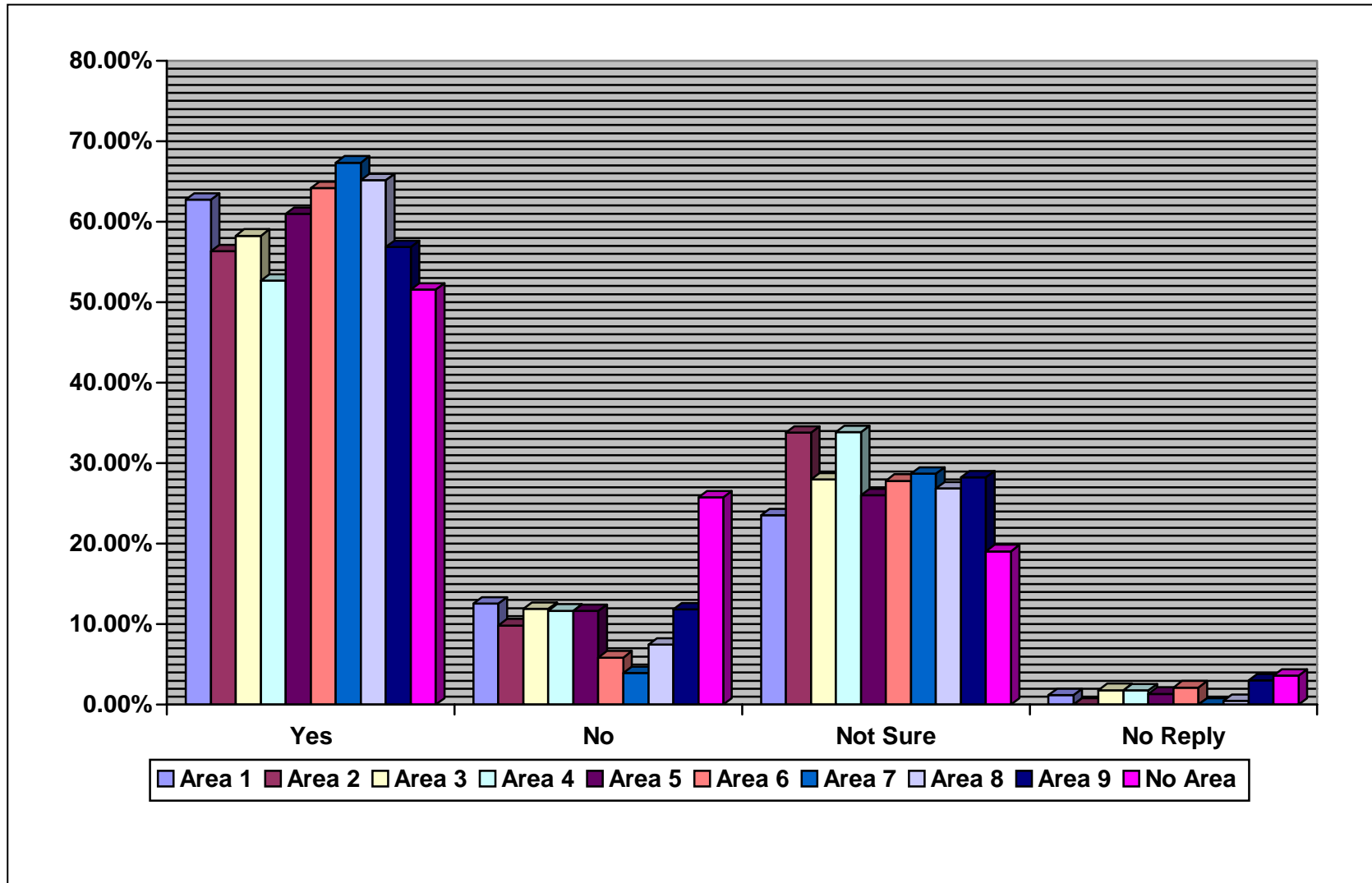

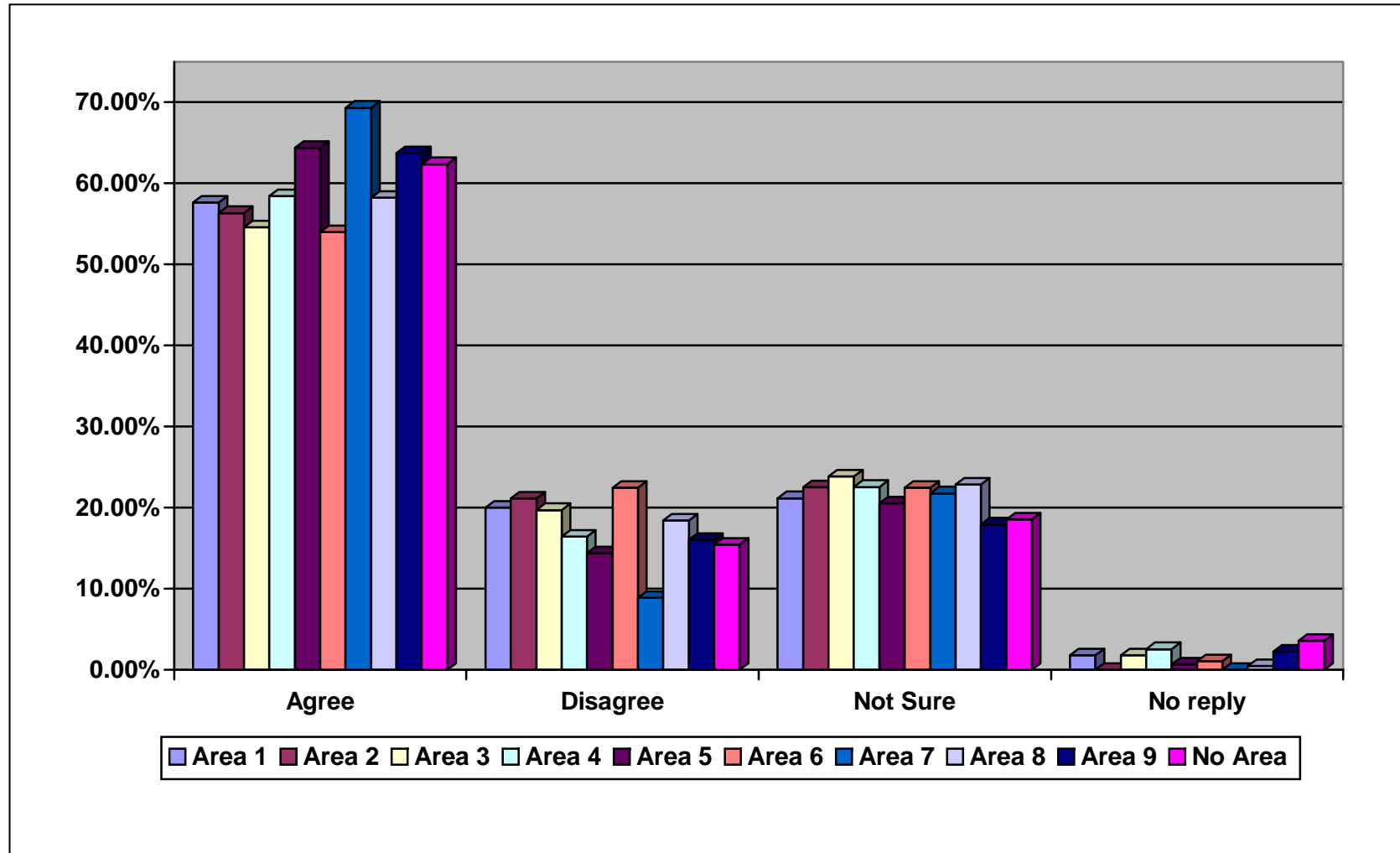

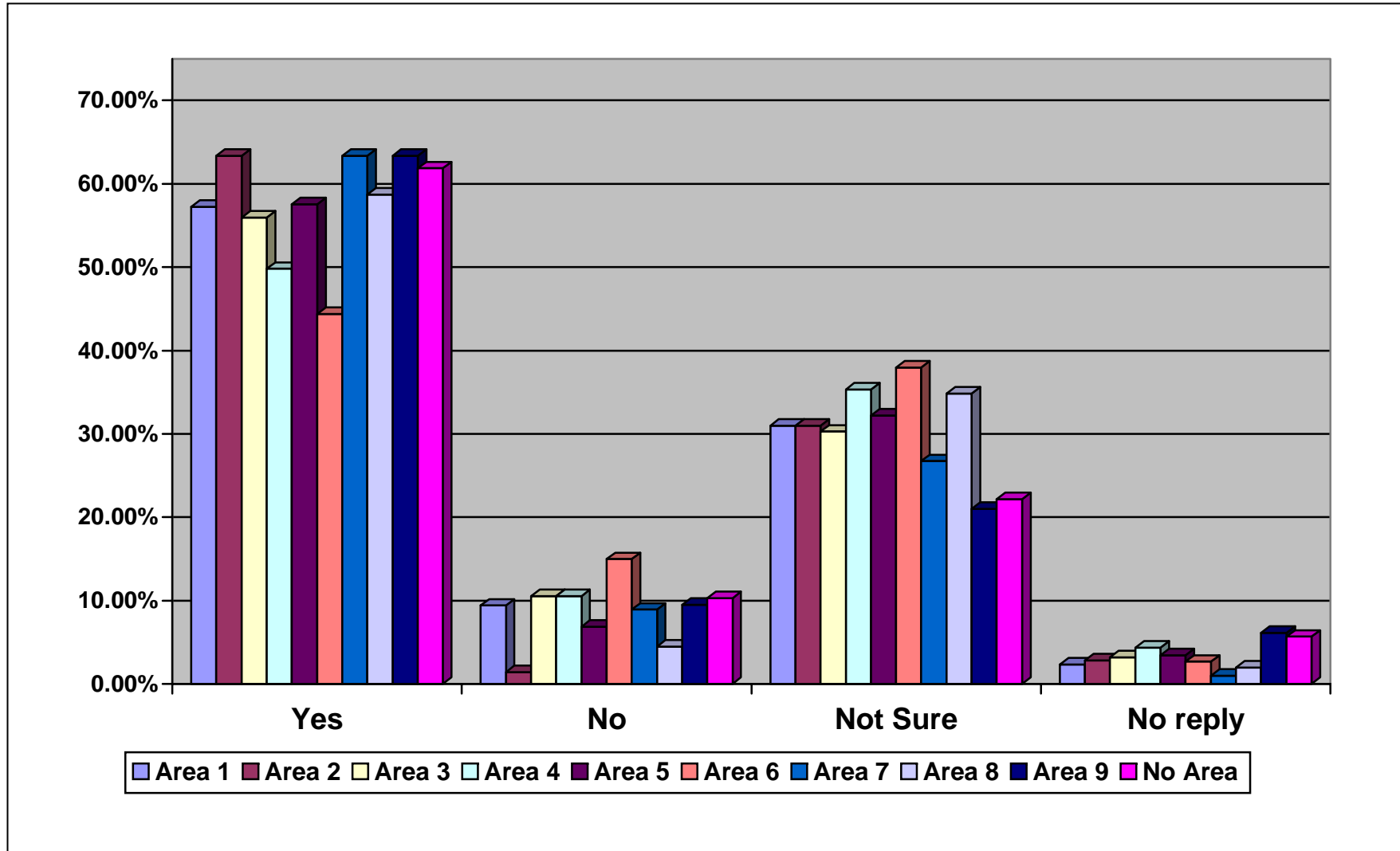

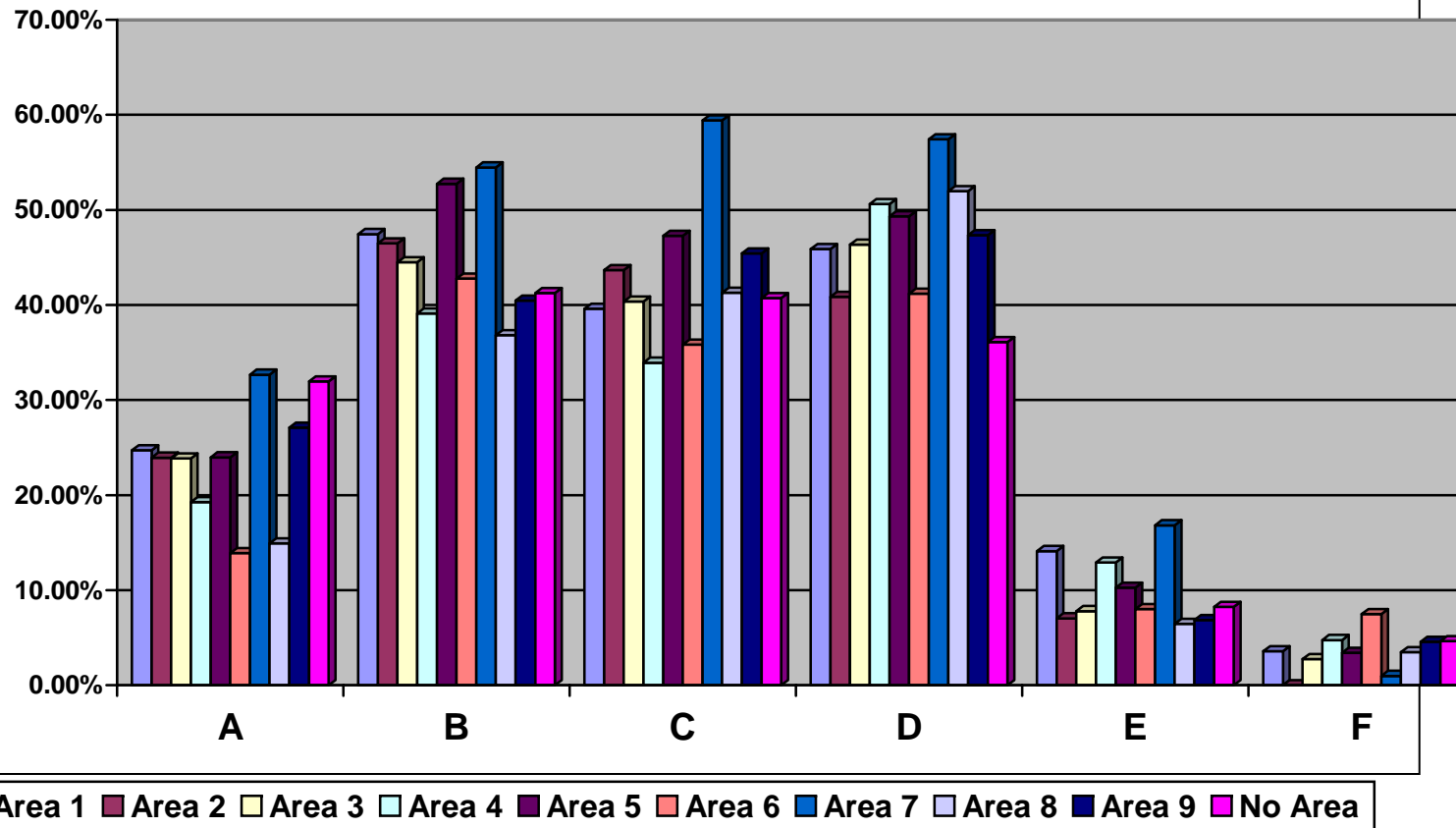

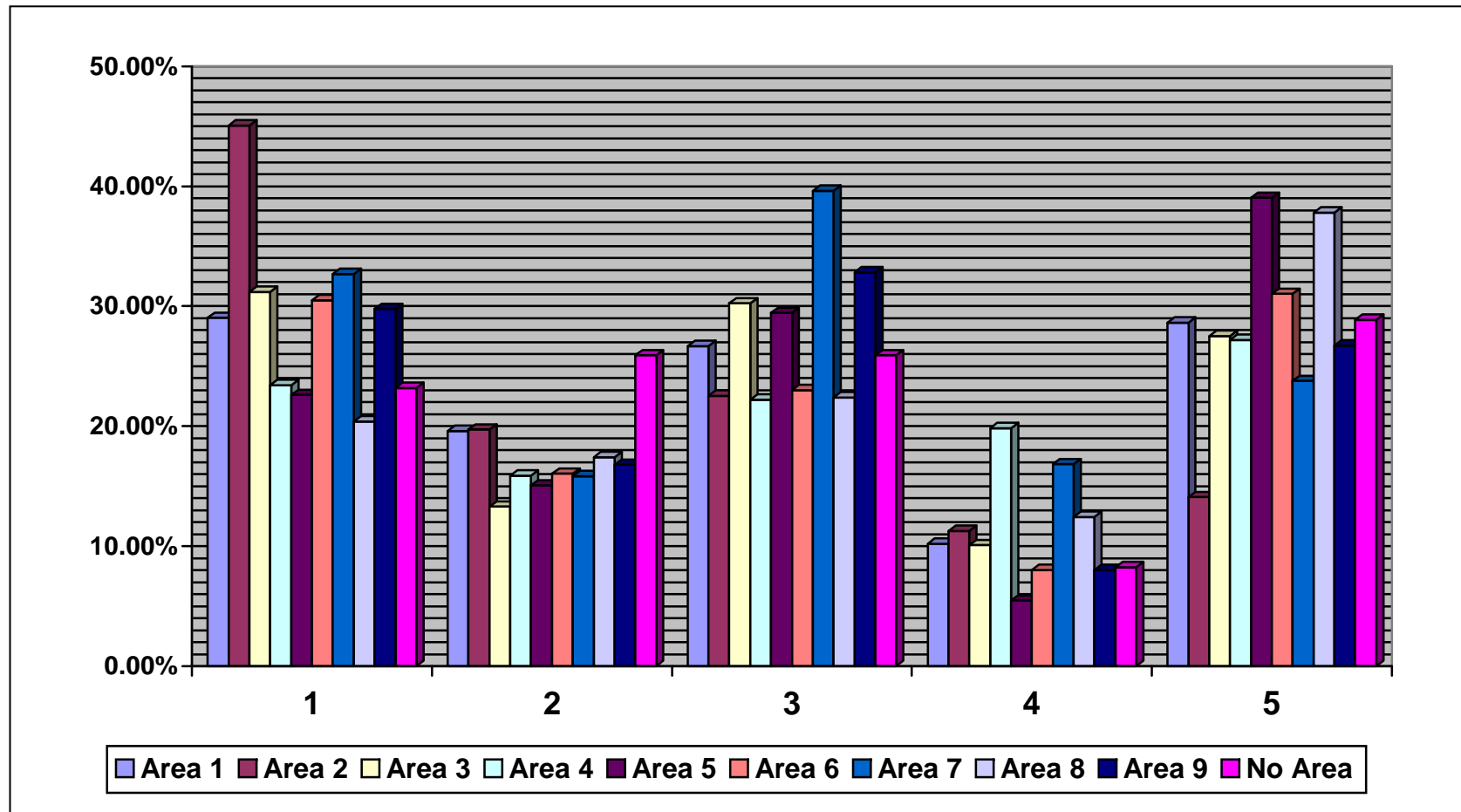

Question 20 – About the person completing this questionnaire



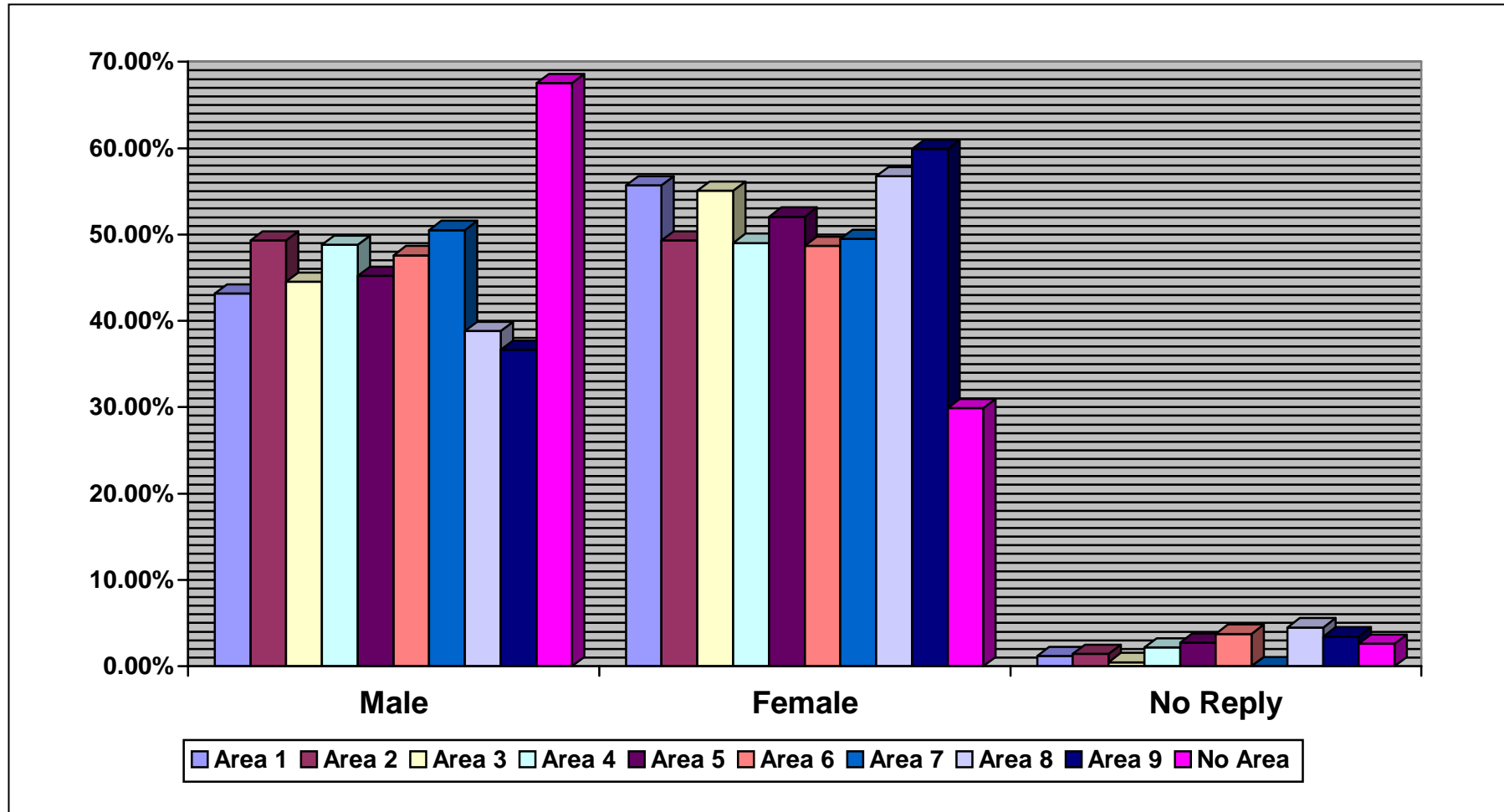

Question 21 – About the person completing this questionnaire



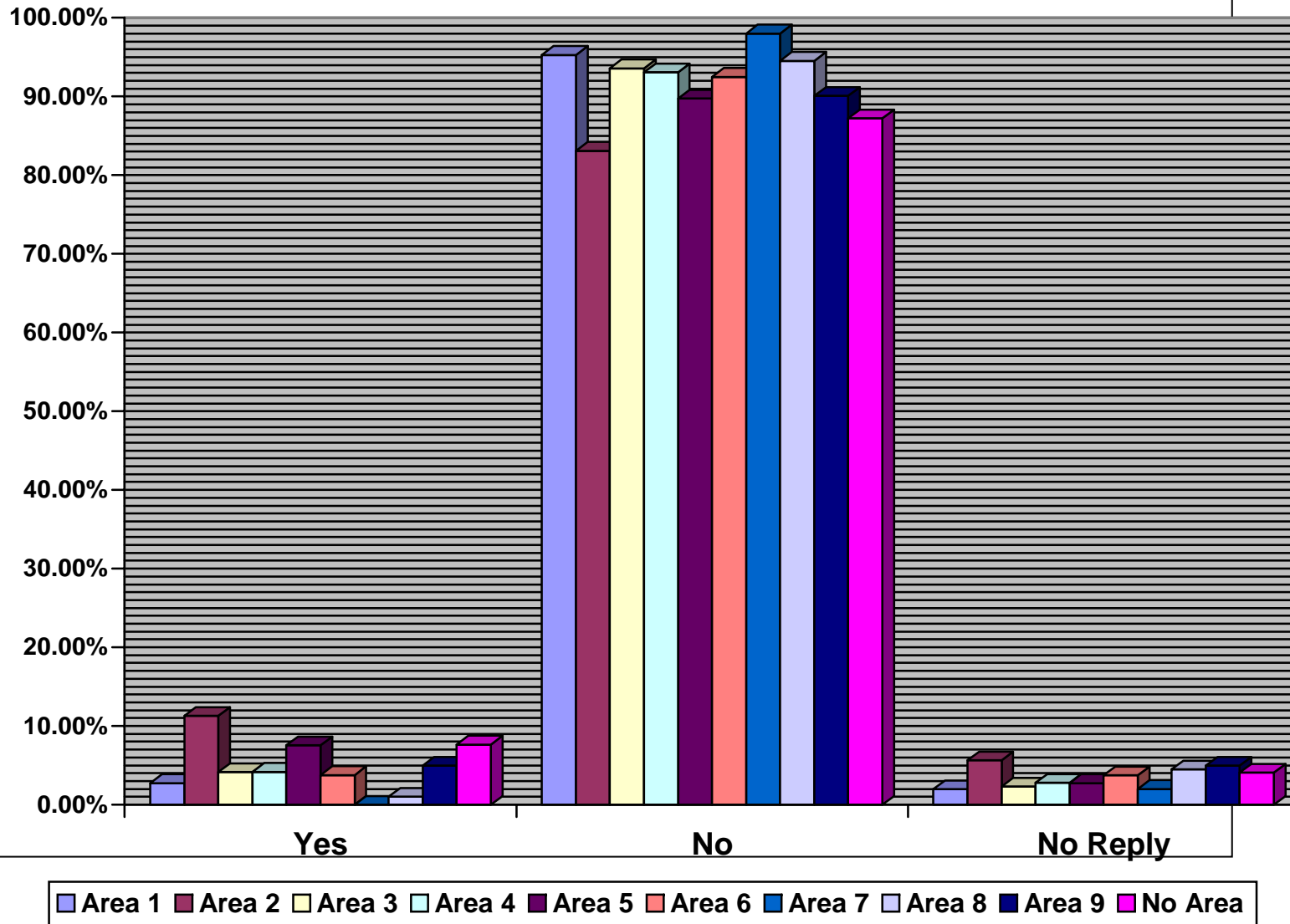

Question 22 – Are you disabled or do you have any special needs?



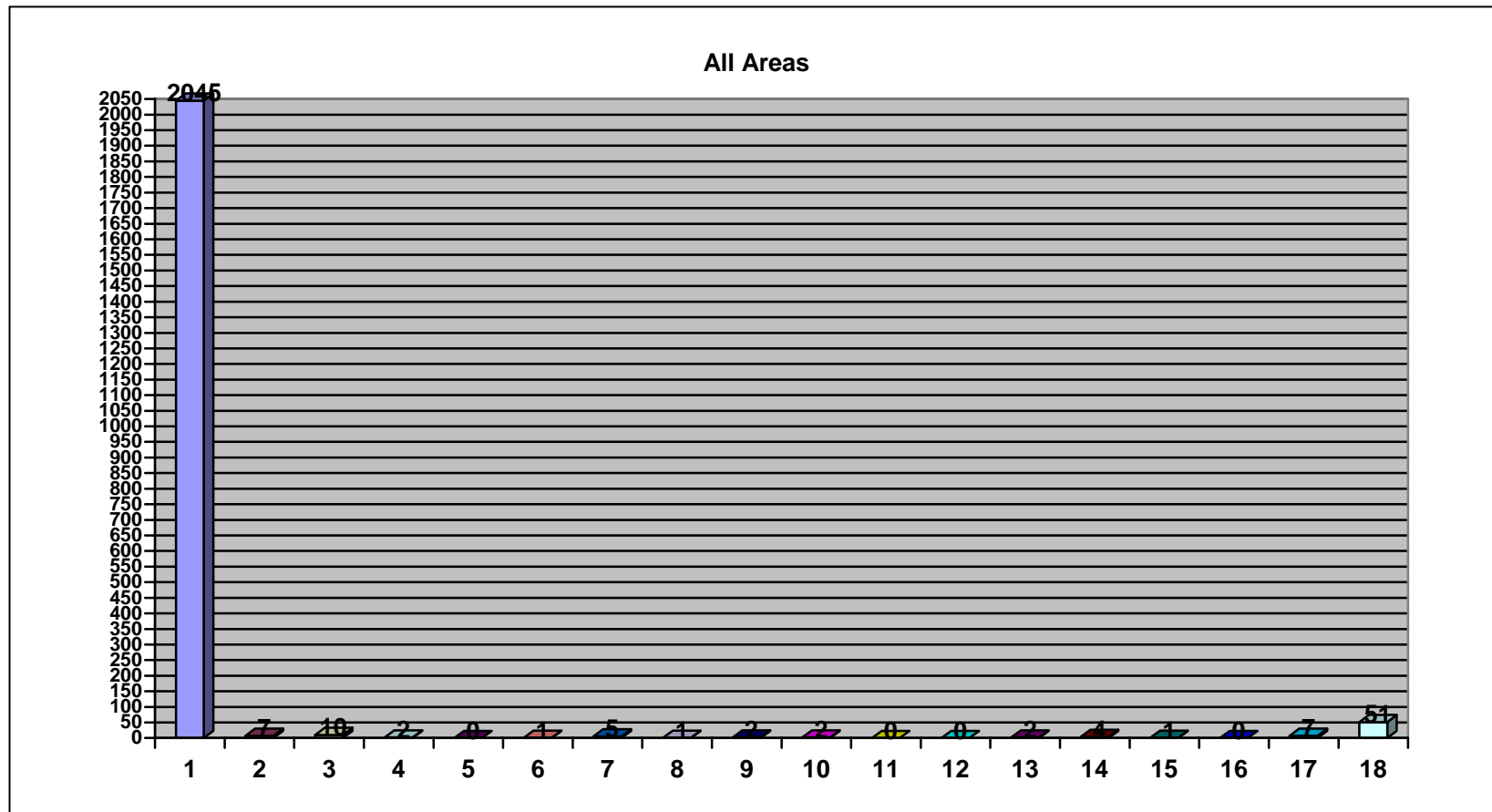
